THE LORRAINE CROSS AND THE CHARLES DE GAULLE MEMORIAL

2HR

Inaugurated in 2008, the Charles de Gaulle Memorial is a historical interpretive site offering an immersive tour through the lens of Charles de Gaulle. The interactive visit features a wide variety of media supports, inviting visitors on a journey through the history of the 20th century.

A panoramic lift makes the climb to the Lorraine Cross, standing 43.5 m tall, with an incredible view of the village.

LA BOISSERIE

Purchased on 9 June, 1934, La Boisserie was the home of Charles and Yvonne de Gaulle.

The site has been open to the public since 1979 and is the starting point of the De Gaulle remembrance trail through the village. Visitors can see the dining room, the office where the General wrote his memoirs, as well as the tree-filled garden and surrounding wooded landscapes. A wonderful chance to admire the scenery that the General held so dear.

THE GENERAL'S TOMB AND THE CHURCH

General de Gaulle is buried in the town cemetery alongside his daughter Anne and his wife Yvonne. Numerous commemorative plaques placed here since the 1970s pay tribute to the Man of June 18th.

Located in the centre of the village, the Notre-Dame parish church houses statues and paintings of significant interest. Its choir has been registered as a Historical Monument since 1913.

Must-see in the church:

The bench reserved for the General.

NOTRE-DAME DES OTAGES

On 24 August 1944, during a religious ceremony, a statue of the Virgin Mary was consecrated on a small clearing on the hill. The statue honours the Colombey villagers who were held hostage following a shootout initiated by a group of FFI (French Forces of the Interior) resistance fighters against the Germans. The hostages were eventually released. A pilgrimage to the site takes place every year on the last Sunday of August.

Colombey-les-Deux-Églises

takes its name from a regional variant of the word colombier (dovecote). The "two churches" part of the name refers to the co-existence of both secular and regular clergy: a parish church that still exists today and the priory of Saint-Jean-Baptiste, a part of the powerful Cluny Abbey, that was seized during the Revolution. Today, the small portion of the priory that remains is closed to visitors.



MIRAGE IV

Unveiled on 8 October 2024 to mark the 60th anniversary of the Strategic Air Force, the Mirage IV No. 55 is a French strategic bomber designed by Dassault Aviation in the 1950s. It was the first carrier of France's nuclear deterrent under General de Gaulle's presidency. It is displayed in the Memorial's car park.

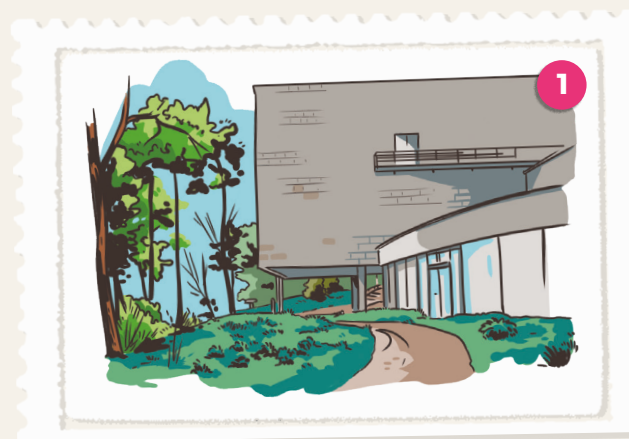
